- 1 pkg. (12 oz.) broccoli slaw mix

Combine slaw mix, bell peppers, craisins, pineapple chunks, onion powder and garlic powder in bowl. Mix the brown sugar in with the dressing until well blended. Add to the salad mixture making sure all ingredients are tossed together. Refrigerate one hour. Add the toasted sliced almonds just before serving.
